

# Ruth - Freestanding Installation instructions

# Included in the package:

- (1) Ruth table light fixture
- (1) Power Supply 24V, 65W

# No Tools required

NOTE: Shade is not adjustable

# How to install:

- 1. Remove the light from the box and place on desired surface.
- Plug the light into the provided power supply and plug the power supply into a 120V source.

# To Operate:

 Touch the light post anywhere above the line on the post to operate (Fig. 1). A quick touch will turn the light on and off.

# To Adjust Brightness:

Touching and holding the light post anywhere above the line on the post (Fig. 1) will adjust the continuous dimming feature.

# Touch light post at any point in this range to operate.

# Ruth - Surface Mount

# Installation Instructions

# Included in the package:

- (1) Ruth table light fixture
- (1) Surface Mount Clamp (if ordered)
- (2) ¼"-20 Button Head Screws
- (1) Power Supply 24V, 65W

# Tools Required:

- 3-1/2" diameter hole saw (if needed)
- 5/32" Allen wrench

NOTE: Shade is not adjustable

### How to Install:

NOTE: The surface mount is designed to fit a 3-1/2" diameter hole in a worksurface. If there is not a hole already in place, cut one before removing the light from the package.

- 1. Remove the light from the box and route the power cord through the hole in the worksurface, place the lamp into the hole, being mindful to not pinch the cord.
  - USB version: Rotate the light so the USB ports are in the desired location relative to the worksurface.

TIP: It can be helpful to have a second person hold the light in place while clamping to ensure orientation stays as desired and the light does not fall over.

- 2. From the underside of the worksurface, install the lower clamp using the provided 1/4"-20 Button Head Screws. Refer to Figs. 1 and 2 for exploded and cross section views showing how the clamp is oriented. Using a 5/32" Allen wrench, tighten the two screws until the clamp is pressed firmly against the underside of the worksurface.
- 3. Plug the light into the provided power supply and plug the power supply into a 120V source.

# To Operate:

 Touch the light post anywhere above the line on the post to operate (Fig. 1). A quick touch will turn the light on and off.

# To Adjust Brightness:

 Touching and holding the light post anywhere above the line on the post (Fig. 1) will adjust the continuous dimming feature.
