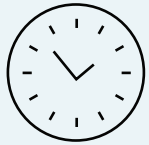


The 3 Drivers of Power Demand

Before specifying power, start by understanding how the space will be used.

Three questions can help clarify what level of power access a space may require.



Duration

How long will the user(s) work in the space?

A quick stop between meetings creates different power needs than a space used for hours at a time.

Consider the length of time:

- ▶ A few minutes?
- ▶ An hour?
- ▶ Half day?
- ▶ Full day?



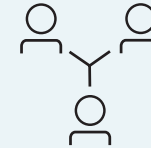
Setup Intensity

What technology will they use while they are there?

The more equipment involved, the greater the demand on the space.

Consider the likely equipment options:

- ▶ Just a phone?
- ▶ Phone + laptop?
- ▶ Laptop + monitor?
- ▶ Additional devices or accessories?



Ownership

How many will use the space simultaneously?

Power requirements vary on whether a space is dedicated, shared, or has frequently changing occupants.

Consider quantity of users:

- ▶ Just one?
- ▶ A small or large team?
- ▶ Multiple users throughout the day?



Our #1 Tip:

Power demand isn't determined by what a space is called or what furniture is specified. It's determined by how people use it.
